INFORMATION ON THE NICHOLAS C. SARRIS SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

Why Was the Nicholas C. Sarris Foundation Established?

It was established to promote, encourage and advance education of members of the Holy Trinity - Holy Cross Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Birmingham, AL at the University of Alabama, Tuscaloosa Campus, by granting to them scholarship assistance.

How was the Foundation Established?

The Foundation was established through a generous grant from the estate of Angeliki Sarris, the wife of Nicholas Sarris.

Who Can Apply?

Only members and/or the children of members of the Holy Trinity-Holy Cross Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Birmingham, AL.

In order to apply and be eligible for a scholarship, an applicant must be:

1. A student in a current or a former graduating class of a high school who is planning to attend the University of Alabama at Tuscaloosa during the current academic year.
2. A student at another college whose application to transfer to the University of Alabama has been accepted.

Who Will Select Recipients for Scholarship Assistance?

Selection of recipients will be made by a Scholarship Selection Committee. Committee members will include the Dean of the Cathedral and persons appointed by him.

Will the Scholarship Grant Go Directly to the Student?

No. The Scholarship award will be paid directly to the University at the beginning of each semester. In the event the student does not enroll at the University, the award will be returned to the Fund. In the event the student does not remain in good standing at the University, or withdraws from the University, the balance of the award will be returned to the Fund.

How Much Money Will Be Given?

The amount of the scholarship award will be determined by the Scholarship Selection Committee. Awards will only be granted from the earnings, dividends and interest of the principle from the Funds held by the Foundation. Amount of money to be granted will be determined by the following criteria: 1. academic achievement and extracurricular activities; 2. church involvement; and 3. financial need.

Can one Reapply for a Scholarship?

Yes. Renewal of a scholarship is not automatic. Scholarships do not carry over automatically. A recipient from a previous year is eligible to reapply for another year.

- Provide official transcripts from your high school and/or college.
- Submit two letters of recommendation: one from a teacher, professor or counselor; the other from a responsible member of the Community. Neither recommendation should be from one who is related to the applicant.
